

Profile of a Disciple

1. Destination - Mission/Vision: Preferred Future
 - a. Jesus Saturation: They can articulate the vision of Jesus Saturation
 - b. Gospel Fluent: They are gospel fluent.
 - i. Gospel Power - 3 Ps
 - ii. Meaning and implications of salvation, justification, adoption, sanctification
 - iii. 4 Gs - God is Great, God is Good, God is Glorious, God is Gracious
 - c. Gospel Identity: They are living out of their identity in Christ as a family of missionary servants who make disciples that make disciples.
2. Vehicles - Method for achieving Preferred Future is all of life discipleship: They are living...
 - a. Life with Jesus: Is practicing the presence of Jesus in the everyday rhythms of life
 - b. Life in Community: is participating in gatherings, a house church and a discipleship group in the everyday rhythms of life
 - c. Life on Life: Is living life-on-life with a least one other person to reproduce the life of Christ in the everyday rhythms of life
 - d. Life on Mission: Is on mission in the everyday rhythms of life
3. Practices - Core Competencies & Tools:
 - a. Practices: Growth practices of a disciple (i.e. seven key practices of Jesus)
 - i. Sabbath - Set aside time to rest, worship and pray
 - ii. Scripture - Study and apply Scripture
 - iii. Spirit Listening & Leading - Hear and respond to God through His Spirit
 - iv. Support - Involvement in supportive discipleship relationships
 - v. Service - Demonstrate the gospel by giving your life away
 - vi. Share - Declare the gospel by speaking the truth in love
 - vii. Supplication - Intercede and interact with God through prayer
 - b. Tools: Knows and uses the Jesus Saturation tools.
 - i. Can articulate the gospel (gospel fluent), including the 3 Ps
 - ii. 4 Qs
 - iii. 4 Gs
 - iv. Fruit to Root
 - v. God's Story: Creation, Fall, Redemption, Restoration
